


RFID in the Danish National Museum

So, how do visitors use it? The RFID tags are hidden underneath the floor, Visitors then use a metal detector with an RFID reader hidden in the search coil to locate an Historical Object. When a Visitor finds an Object that has an RFID tag hidden in it, the visitor is then told story about the Historical Object in the form of a video on the screen on the detector and the audio is heard through the headphones. The Exhibition was opened by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
